

The Honorable John A. Manglona, Associate Justice

Justice John A. Manglona, born on Rota on June 12, 1959, has been a justice of the Commonwealth Supreme Court since May 2000. He served a four-year term as a Designated Justice in the Guam Supreme Court from 1999-2003. He was also an associate judge in the Superior Court from 1998 to 2000.

Justice Manglona graduated from Father Duenas Memorial High School in Guam in 1977 and received his B.A. in Political Economy from the University of California at Berkeley in 1981. He graduated from Creighton University School of Law (J.D.,

1984) and the University of the Pacific, McGeorge School of Law (LL.M in Taxation, 1988). Prior to his appointment to the bench, Justice Manglona was in private practice.

Justice Manglona is married to US District Court Judge Mona V. Manglona, and they have two children.
