

Roof Repairs Begin

The Judiciary recently began repairs on the Guma' Hustisia's roof



in Susupe. After years of significant water leaks and water damage, the project is a much-needed improvement. The contractor is removing the insulation from the building's roof—which has been in place for over 16 years—because water was getting under the insulation and seeping into the building through cracks on the roof. After taking off the insulation, the

cracks will be filled in and new insulation will be installed. The project should be completed in early 2015.
