The 14th Annual Pretrial, Probation, and Parole Supervision Week Proclamation Signed by the Governor and Chief Justice

The 14th Annual Pretrial, Probation, and Parole Supervision Week proclamation was signed by Chief Justice Alexandro C. Castro and Governor Eloy S. Inos on Friday, July 11th. During July 13-19th, community correction professionals engaged in a number of activities designed to build moral and improve skills, including officers' in-service training and a Top Gun Competition.



Mass was conducted on Sunday, July 13 at 7:30am at the San Jose Parish. On Monday and Tuesday, the 14th and 15th of July, resolutions were signed on Tinian and Rota acknowledging correction officers' contribution as a force for positive change on their respective islands. On July 14th through July 18th, Exhibits displayed at the Court House in Susupe were opened for public viewing.

The Proclamation signing's guest Speaker Associate Judge David A. Wiseman said, "Our society faces many challenges in its efforts to deal with those who violate the law. Judges must effectively sanction those offenders who come before the court and send a consistent message to those who do not by dealing with each case in a manner that will protect the public, hold offenders accountable to the victim and the community, and provide education or treatment services for the offender."
